- **The MIGA, Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency**, was created in 1988 and is part of the World Bank Group..
- MIGA promotes foreign direct investments in emerging markets, in order to sustain economic growth and reduce poverty and to better the quality of life of the populations.
- MIGA encourages investments in favour of development in markets keeping away traditional investors and insurers. The agency obtains results while ensuring investors against political risks such as expropriation, breach of contract, war and civil disturbance, currency transfer restriction: the agency helps resolve potential disputes to the satisfaction of all parties and help developing countries attract and keep private investments.
- Since it exists, MIGA has given for more than 18,5 milliards USD insurance coverage for about 600 investment projects in 96 developing countries. Actually, MIGA has a guarantee portfolio of about 6,5 milliards USD.
- Those projects help create employment, furnish water and electricity as well as other basic infra-structures, to re-establish the financial systems and generate fiscal income, to transfer competences, and technological know-how, and help developing countries to exploit their natural resources within environmental viability.
